We're so happy to dance with you! To help classes run smoothly and create the best experience for everyone, please keep the following in mind:

Arrival Time

We kindly ask that dancers arrive 10 minutes early for every class. The studio will open 15 minutes before class begins and no earlier, giving dancers time to get settled and ready to dance.

If your dancer needs to arrive early due to school schedules, please connect with Miss Amy ahead of time so arrangements can be made.

Attendance and Absences

Consistent attendance is important for progress and confidence in class. If your dancer will be missing a class, please email info@attitudedancecompany.com to let us know.

Please note that we are unable to offer make up classes or prorated tuition unless the studio needs to cancel a class.

Pick Up Time

All dancers should be picked up within 10 to 15 minutes after class ends each evening. Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe and supervised.

Private Lessons

- No show or no call private lessons will be charged the full lesson fee.
- Cancellations made within 24 hours of the scheduled lesson will also be charged the lesson fee.
- All private lessons must be paid in full before instruction begins.

Thank you for your understanding and continued support. We truly appreciate being part of your dancer's journey.

Waiting Room

To help us create a safe, calm, and focused environment for all of our dancers, we kindly ask for your support with the following studio guidelines:

★ Supervision

For everyone's safety, children under the age of 12 must be supervised at all times. Please note that the studio is responsible for dancers only during their scheduled class times.

★ Lobby Quiet Zone

Our lobby is a Quiet Zone, designed to support focus and a peaceful atmosphere. We appreciate your help in keeping voices and noise levels low.

★ Quiet Room Use

The Quiet Room is a dedicated space for work and homework. To maintain a calm environment, it is not intended for play or recreational activities.

★ Lobby Safety

To keep everyone safe and comfortable, we ask that dancers and siblings walk calmly in the lobby—no running, screaming, or acro tricks in this space.

★ Classroom Viewing

For your convenience, our younger classes will be streamed to the viewing TVs located in the lobby.

★ Classroom Focus

To minimize distractions and support learning, parents, family members, and friends are not permitted inside the classrooms during class time.

★ Food & Drink

Food and drinks are welcome in the lobby only. The Student Lounge, Quiet Room, and classrooms are food- and drink-free to help keep our spaces clean and safe.

★ Studio Care

We appreciate everyone helping to clean up after themselves. If anything needs attention, please let a staff member know—we're always happy to help!

- Below are the details and some new improvements for you to be aware of when registering for Spring Session classes.

What's Included in Class Rates:

- 12 Weeks of Classes
- Costume
- Registration & Administrative Fees

What's Not Included in Class Rates:

- Tights
- Shoes

Payment Options:

- Something New: A 5% discount will be provided if you pay for Spring Session 2026 in full by 12/31/25. That works out to roughly one free class per session season!

There is also a Payment Plan Option:

- 5 Equal Monthly Payments
- Months: January-May
- Auto-Withdrawn on the 1st of the Month
- Change in Registration and Payment Processing
- To clarify the previous issues with reporting of balances due and simplify the auto-payment process, we are changing up part of registration through Dance Studio Pro (DSP).
- After you register for the class(es) for your child:
- If you are paying in full, process your payment through DSP (as done previously).

- If you are paying via the monthly payment plan, you will NOT process payment through DSP. Instead, when you receive the Welcome Email after registration, there will be a link to Square to enter your payment information.
- Throughout the year, if you register for Sessions, Classes and/or Competitions and select the payment plan option, there will be a separate auto-withdrawal for each time you registered.

For example:

- Your child is registered for Studio Competition and you have a monthly payment being withdrawn. Then you register for Fall Session - the new monthly payment will be a separate auto-withdrawal, so there will be two withdrawal amounts until Fall Session payment plan is complete.

Registration Dates for Spring Session:

Registration Opens: Monday, December 23, 2025

Registration Closes: Friday, February 13, 2026

Additional Information

- We are cashless. That means everything must be paid by credit card, debit card or ACH (e-check). (The one exception to this is concessions at the front desk.)
- All fees for all of Spring Session Classes are listed in one upfront price.
- Reminder: Each class registration for Spring Session requires a costume, so the fee for the costume is included, but for tights and shoes, you will need to purchase those separately.
- Payment Plan balances will be available to view in Square and Dance Studio Pro (DSP). Square will update automatically as the payments are auto-withdrawn. DSP will be updated once a week.
- Please note that we are working with professionals who are trying to navigate making multiple software programs work together in the best way possible for you, so some processes listed here may be subject to change. If anything changes, we will communicate it as soon as possible.

We appreciate your patience, understanding and positivity as we work toward these improvements for you!

Class Attire

FOUR

- All hair must be pulled completely back and out of the face.
- No large jewelry allowed for safety purposes.
- Proper shoes for each class are required. No Barefeet or Socks Allowed.

Inclement Weather

FIVE

- If the studio closes due to inclement weather, we will post on our social media pages and send out a mass email.
- Classes will only have a make up if more than 2 of the same classes needed to be canceled.

Fingerprint Access

SIX

- Our doors will remain locked during the school season for security purposes.
- All dancers ages 7 & up will need to have their fingerprint registered in our system to access the doors.
- All parent/guardians will be required to enroll their fingerprint in the system for entrance.
- We do NOT use any fingerprint information for anything other than entrance to the facility.

Security Cameras

SEVEN

- Security cameras are running 24/7 in all classrooms, lobby, student lounge and quiet room.
- Please note we also have security cameras surrounding the building as well.

CONCESSIONS

We will have limited concessions being sold at the front desk. CASH or CARD ONLY.

Note: We do have water bottle filler, however, it does not have a drinking fountain connected. Please bring your own water bottles to fill. Individual water bottles are available for purchase only: \$1.
